

Users of the Transfer Station will pay by the bag to dispose of trash in the compactor. Recycling will continue to be covered by the purchase of the "Annual Permit". Each vehicle must, as in past years, have a Cummington "Annual Permit" sticker in a visible area on the drivers side of the vehicle in order to enter the T.S. But that Permit will now cost only \$40 per household.

\$40 - Annual Permit - per household, no matter the ages of residents, whether seasonal or full-time, etc.

\$1 tag - Each trash bag of up to 15 gallons (most "kitchen trash bags").

\$2 tag - Each bag, barrel or other container up to 39 gallons will require any combination of tags equaling \$2.

\$3 - Any bag or container over 39 gallons will require any combination of tags equaling \$3.

The tag(s) need not be attached to the bag but simply handed to the T.S. Attendant. ***NOTE: Change WILL NOT be given*** if the correct denomination of tags are not available. If the customer does not have the appropriate amount of tags and no means to purchase the tags on site, please be prepared to **TAKE YOUR TRASH HOME** with you. ***Also attendants will no longer empty your vehicle. So please be prepared before coming to the transfer station.***

"Annual Permits"-- and tags will be sold at the at the transfer station during operating hours.

Payment should be by check. Each purchaser will receive an annual sticker, and can buy tags in both \$1.00 and \$2.00 denominations as desired. **Annual Permits must be displayed in a visible area on the drivers side of the vehicle starting August 1st of each year.**

When more tags are needed, they are available at the Transfer Station, again with checks preferred, but cash accepted.

Payment for construction debris and metals will continue as before.

Vehicles using the open boxes **MUST NOT EXIT** through the entrance gate. Remember this is not free. Hauling stuff away costs, so please check with an attendant prior to disposing anything into the open boxes! ***This will be strictly enforced.***
