**Cell Phones and their batteries**



Rechargeable batteries from razors, toothbrushes, flashlights, hand held vacuums and their batteries: **only bag component containing the battery i.e. do not include razor head, toothbrush attachment, charging unit, etc.**

## Button and lithium batteries: Examples

Button Batteries must be sandwiched between two pieces of clear packing tape so that they cannot come in contact with one another. Hearing aid batteries can be placed back into their original dial dispenser and the package placed in a zip lock bag.
