

Board of Health Fees Adopted 10-15-2013

Food Services – Inspection/Permit Fees

Restaurant/Market: \$25 per hour per inspector

Bakery: \$25

Temporary vendors at fairs, etc., also seasonal, such as ice cream, sugar shack.

Booths/Perishable foods- \$10; Booths/Non-Perishable foods - \$5

Pavilion at ballfield (for food selling only; does not apply to private, non-food selling functions) - \$10

Farm Stands: \$25

Kitchen Safety / Health Refrigeration

Summer Camp, including day camp: \$25 per hour per inspector

Septic Related

Annual Hauler/Installer Permit: \$50

Witnessing perc test: \$25/hour

Viewing of installed system before covering: no charge (Board of Health signature is required for Certificate of Compliance to be valid)

Other

Burial permit: no charge

Death certificate: \$10

Annual transfer station permits: \$40 (\$5 for a second sticker)

Transfer station bag tags: \$1 and \$2 each

Pricelist available upon request for large items, metal, construction materials

Inspections and tests stimulated by Title II complaints, tenant/landlord dispute, etc.:

The Board of Health reserves the right to pass on to property owners the costs for lab work, visits and inspections, drafting reports and other actions necessary to resolve these situations. BoH members' time may be compensated at the rate of \$15/hour.
